Join us in a studio visit to Jenny Turpin's whose career started at the TBSSS in Broadway With a career spanning twenty-five years, join us for this fascinating insight into the work of Jennifer Turpin as we tour her Sydney studio.

The work of sculptor and installation artist Jennifer Turpin has brought her acclaim and controversy. The use of water and kinetic elements in her solo and collaborative projects has created a body of work that has a dynamic and harmonious impact upon the Australian landscape.

Winner of 2003 Lloyd Rees Civic Award, RAIA for her collaborative work 'Storm Waters' (2000/02 with Michaelie Crawford), Turpin was unexpectedly thrown into the media spotlight in August 2003 when the monumental sculpture 'Fan' (concept & design commissioned by National Planning Authority, Canberra) was embroiled in a conservative political backlash that eventually ended the project. To this day, 'Fan' remains a cautionary tale of the power to determine the 'public' in public art.
