A two day workshop with Abby Parkes



In this workshop you will be guided through the traditional method of working directly in wax. You will carve, model and construct a small, 15cm max, sculpture in wax. (This workshop does not cover the cost of bronze casting, however your sculpture could be taken to a bronze foundry to be cast) The pros and con of working with this versatile material will be discussed and notes provided. Abby has worked at Crawford's Casting and has used this method in creating her own sculptures.
